

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for Sanitary Sewer and Water System Improvements, FY2010: Phase 2, City of Waycross, Georgia will be received at City Hall in Waycross, until 11:00 a.m. o'clock legal prevailing time on August 26, 2010, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read aloud. No bid may be withdrawn after the closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of ninety (90) calendar days. The bids will be evaluated without discussions with the bidders.

The Work to be done consists of furnishing all materials and equipment and performing all labor necessary to remove and replace approximately 4600 LF of sanitary sewer main, 1600 LF of water main, and 16,000 SY of asphalt paving, plus all incidental work required. The work will be awarded in one contract.

Plans, Specifications and Contract Documents are on file at the office of the City Engineer in City Hall, Waycross, Georgia and may be obtained from Imaging Technologies, 655 North Avenue, Baconsfield Center, Macon, Georgia 31211; (478) 746-3331, for approximately \$ 75 plus shipping.

Payment of the Contract amount will be made on a periodic basis on applications for payment from the contractor and approved by the engineer based on work accomplished, products furnished and products stored at the site. Such progress payment requests shall be submitted by the contractor no later than the 25th day of each month during the term of the Contract and shall be paid by the Owner within thirty (30) days after receipt of approved progress payment requests, less the retainage and other deductions provided in the Contract Documents. Further details concerning the payment provisions of the Contract are contained in Article 14 of the General Conditions of the Contract Documents.

Bonds: All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount bid. The Successful Bidder, if awarded the Contract, will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and Payment Bond, each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract amount.

The surety company on the contract performance bond shall be a surety company authorized to do business in the State of Georgia. Said bond and surety shall be subject to approval by the attorney for the OWNER.

Attorneys-in-fact who sign Bid Bonds must file with the bond a certified and effectively dated copy of their Power of Attorney. This shall be attached to the Bid Bond.

Owner's Right: The contract shall be awarded to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder whose bid meets the requirements and criteria set forth in the advertisement for bids; provided, however, that if the bid from the lowest responsible and responsive bidder exceeds the funds budgeted for the public works construction contract, the governmental entity may negotiate with such apparent low bidder to obtain a contract price within the budgeted amount. Such negotiations may include changes in the scope of work and other bid requirements. The OWNER reserves the right to waive minor irregularities. The OWNER shall have the right to reject any and all bids and readvertise for other bids when the bids submitted are not, in its judgment, satisfactory.
